What:

The 2010 Campus Impact Award is HLA's and SFLA's pro-life contest for your student club. Clubs that make a big impact on campus with HLA materials will be considered for prize awards. Creativity is encouraged. To be considered you must use HLA materials and submit a report of your activities by the deadline. Projects must take place between February 1st and March 31st.

Judging:

Representatives of HLA and SFLA will judge submissions based on evidence of campus impact provided by student clubs. Your report could include, but is not limited to the following:

- ◆ Articles or letters to the editor in the student newspaper
- ◆ Dialogues on campus (video or audio recordings)
- ◆ Photos
- ◆ Blog discussions
- ◆ Personal stories
- ◆ Podcasts
- ◆ Written descriptions
- ◆ Facebook events, causes, etc.
